

FORT CAMPBELL JOE SWING BINGO

GENERAL RULES



1. Bingo play is restricted to authorized personnel and bona fide guests ages 18 or older.
2. Customers must have a valid DoD identification card in their possession, or be a bona fide guest in order to be a bingo winner.

3. All customers must purchase at least one regular game card pack. You must be playing a pack to be in the facility. Splitting of packs is prohibited. Bingo will not be paid if a pack is split.

4. All sales are final. For the customer's protection as well as ours, the customer will count cards and change before they leave the cash register. The NAFI/Management is not responsible for discrepancies after the customer leave the cash register, or the floor worker leaves their table.

5. For the customer's protection as well and the NAFI, the customer will count their prize money upon receipt. Award of all prizes is final and The NAFI/Management is not responsible for prize money after the customer has received it.

6. Minimum number of players required to play the entire program with full payouts is fifty (50). A minimum of twenty-five (25) players are required in order to play an adjusted payout session.

7. In the event of poor participation or inclement weather, prizes will be adjusted to not more than 75% of the door intake for that session.

8. Bingo play will begin after the operational condition of the bingo blower, flashboard, etc., has been inspected by at least two bingo players selected at random. Inspections will be conducted at the beginning of each session, and will include verification of the bingo balls in the flashboard switch and the dumping of the balls into the blower. If there is a mechanical malfunction during the bingosession which causes a game to be replayed, all customers will receive an equal number of their originally purchased cards to replay the game.

9. Number is official when called; the bingo ball in the monitor is NOT official until called. Once a bingo ball has been removed from the bingo monitor it must be called. "Bingo" must be called before the next number is drawn from the bingo monitor.

10. Bingo flashboards may not always light and are not official. If a difference exists between the number of balls shown on the flashboards and the number of balls selected, the number of balls selected will be the official record of the game.

11. All winning cards will be verified by a disinterested bingo player and a bingo operations employee, winners will sign their name and indicate their Social Security Number, address and telephone number on the prize receipt form. When there is more than one winner of a prize, cash prizes will be divided equally.

12. The number of cards you are playing must match with the cash receipt or the bingo will not be paid.

13. An Ink Dauber must be used on all paper cards.



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GENERAL RULES (CONTINUED)



14. Any disfigured or altered cards will not be paid. Bingo cards will not be taken out of or brought into the facility.

15. Serial number on bingo cards must match the serial numbers used for the session of bingo being played or the bingo will not be honored.

16. You must YELL "BINGO" loud enough for the CALLER to hear you before the game is closed, "Sleeper Bingo" will not be honored. You must bingo on the last number called. Floor workers will try to insure that "BINGOS" are heard.

17. Any bingo card/pack must be played on games for which they were purchased. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the cards and refunds will not be given.

18. All bingo prizes will be cash if they are \$1,199.00 or lower. Any prize over \$1,199.00 will be paid by check and mailed from the NAF Financial Services Office (NFS) to the address indicated on the prize receipt form. Furthermore, bingo prize checks will not be cashed at the bingo site. It is mandatory that the winner's printed name, address, Social Security Number, and signature be collected on the Bingo Form Prize and Payout Voucher. Prizes WILL NOT be awarded without this information.

19. Management reserves the right to change or delete any of the games or cash awards without prior notice.

20. Patrons may bring limited outside food items and/or drinks (no alcohol) of their choice into the facility. Please be mindful of possible food allergies that can be triggered and refrain from foods with strong odors. Limited food and beverage will be available for purchase.

21. IAW AR 600-63, Army Health Promotion, paragraph 7 to 3a smoking is not permitted in any federal facility. There is an area outside provided for those who desire to smoke. Any play missed while smoking is the player's responsibility and cannot be made up.

22. Customers use electronic bingo machines at their own risk. The NAFI/Management is not responsible for malfunction of power bingo machines.

23. Direct line supervisors, employees involved in bingo operations and their immediate family members are prohibited from participating in any bingo operations at Joe Swing.

24. In the event of inclement weather causes the Fort Campbell Installation to be closed or otherwise deemed unsafe to travel the roads, Joe Swing Bingo will also be closed. An announcement of any closures or changes in schedules will be posted on the campbell.armymwr.com website and the FortCampbellMWR Facebook page, and the recorded information line at (270) 412-8735.

25. As a consideration we ask that all patrons turn cell phones to vibrate only: If you must take a call, please step outside. Any play missed for taking a call is the player's responsibility and cannot be made up. Talking should be kept to a minimum and in a low to moderate tone. Profanity, loud noise and other acts that disturb other players are prohibited. Violators are subject to removal from premises without a refund.

26. The facility management reserves the right to refuse admission and service.
